Central Otago, New Zealand ~ Dry & delicate. Pear, spice and citrus aromas are followed by flavours of stonefruit with a delicate creamy like texture, texture is underpinned by mineral notes and refreshing acidity.

Waitaki Valley, New Zealand ~ Low acidity, a subtle hint of sweetness. Full bodied with a rich texture and a long luscious finish.

Esk Valley, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand ~ Held in French oak for six months to increase mouthfeel. Aromatics of mandarin peel, apricots and honeysuckle with a richness of texture & refreshing dry finish.

Central Otago, New Zealand ~ Sweet tropical fruits dominate the mid-palate. Sweetness is integrated by the racy acidity. This contributes to the wine's considerable length and intrigue with the residual sugar being hardly noticeable amongst the delicate framework.

Martinborough, New Zealand ~ Deliciously fruity and mouth-wateringly chewy, with wholemeal creaminess of pureed broccoli. With juicy persimmon and crisp nashi pear flavours and a substantial chord of acidity.

Alsace, France ~ Very young, pale green in colour. With fresh and lively aromas of green apple, lime, white peach and fresh moss. This wine is dry and fresh with a fine ripe acidity that quenches the thirst.

The wine offers pristine fruit characters with flinty undertones, beautifully structured by bright acidity, finishing long and crisp.

Tuscany, Italy - Predominantly Sangiovese with a small portion of Merlot in the blend. Ripe red berry fruit with lovely warm hints of oak and savoury meaty characters. Dry with a medium body and silky tannins leading into a lasting finish.

Parnasse Syrah Pays d'Oc 2016 **\$50**
Languedoc-Roussillon, France ~ Medium-bodied, silky and elegant. This is a richly sweet, up-front, boldly-fruited Syrah with flavours of dark raspberries, blackberries, boysenberries and plum jam notes on a supple palate.
